Amendment to Waste Management Plan

Management and disposal of non- leaking and leaking ballast if found to contain PCB's:

- All Ballast will be removed from the light fixtures prior to removal
- All Ballasts will be separated into three categories
 - Marked as Non-PCB ballasts
 - Un-Marked (will be assumed as containing PCB's)
 - Marked as PCB containing Ballasts
- Ballasts will be inventoried and containerized in their respective categories.
- If Ballasts are leaking or have cracks, the ballasts will be removed and placed in an approved drum for disposal.
- If the light fixture is contaminated it will be cleaned to less than 10 micrograms/100 square centimeters contamination before disposal by an approved PCB contractor and is not considered part of this contract. DFD will be contacted for approval prior to commencing with the cleanup.
- PCB Ballasts shall be placed in approved type 17C or type 17H drums.
- PCB drums shall be placed in storage with the cover on in a location on site marked as Hazardous Waste.
- A written report will be provided to DFD representative with the total count and where they will be stored.
- Non-PCB ballasts will be disposed of by the contractor.

Liquid (oil) filled transformers:

- All transformers observed to date have been dry. The only wet transformer is on the south side of the building and is to remain in place.
- All transformers will be inspected prior to removal/demolition
- In the event that a wet transformer is discovered, Veit will contact DFD for additional testing. Upon results of the testing and an equitable contract adjustment, oils will be removed per local, state, & federal regulations.
 - If oil is clean of contaminants, it will be pumped and recycled by a certified recycler.
 - If oil contains contaminants (PCB's) a certified contractor will reclaim the oils and dispose of per local, state, and federal regulations.

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Sewer line connected to cistern:

- The sewer line will remain as is per this contract.
- In the event that the sewer line is requested to be removed by change order, appropriate sampling will be conducted.

Stained concrete, bricks, and block will be tested for PCB’s:

- There are no suspected or known areas where materials containing PCB’s have been stored.
- There are no known stained concrete, brick, and block within the demolition limits.
- If previously concealed stains are encountered, Veit will contact DFD for additional testing.
- Upon results of testing and an equitable contract adjustment, Veit will dispose of the materials per local, state, and federal regulations.

Storm water management, housekeeping, and site maintenance

- All contractual provisions will be met in full for: storm water management, housekeeping and overall site maintenance. This includes proper disposal of refuse than contains lead based paint at a certified landfill.

Air Monitoring:

- Low volume air monitors will be set up at 4 points and will test for nuisance dust. 15 micro-grams per cubic meter.
- Reporting will be made to the DOA per contract.

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
